■ Yetter adds fertilizer bar for All Steer High Capacity Cart

Yetter Manufacturing has developed a fertilizer toolbar to go with the All Steer High Capacity Cart they introduced two years ago. It's called the All Steer Plus Fertilizer Toolbar.

The toolbar has a bridge hitch that attaches to the front axle of the cart after the pull hitch is removed. It is raised and lowered hydraulically and floats on parallel linkage. The pull hitch can be used to pull the cart behind a planter. Then the bridge hitch can be installed for sidedressing liquid nitrogen.

Two sizes of toolbars

The All Steer Plus Fertilizer Toolbar is available in 12-row and 16-row models. For people doing custom work, the 16-row version easily converts to a 12-row model by folding the outer wings.

Both the 12-row (30-foot) and 16-row (40-foot) versions fold to 17 feet for transport. The 12-row version folds once, and the 16-row version folds twice.

The box frame toolbar features two 4x4-inch steel tubes spaced 8" apart. That design provides a lot of flexibility for adding coulters. Several different fertilizer coulters with knife or injection nozzles are available.

Prices vary depending on which style of openers are ordered. The approximate price of a 12-row toolbar with 11 fertilizer coulters and two gauge wheels is \$12,500. The approximate price of a 16-row toolbar with 15 fertil-

izer coulters and two gauge wheels is \$15,350. (Those prices do not include the All Steer Cart.)

Cart is the foundation

Yetter started building All Steer High Capacity Carts two years ago. Their key feature is that all four wheels steer. Consequently, the rear tires follow the front tires for precise tracking.

Both axles pivot on fifth wheels, and the front axle pivots up or down from the centerline to relieve stress on uneven terrain.

The standard version comes with a 1,600-gallon elliptical tank, hazard lights, and 18.4x26-inch tires. The 10-ply industrial tractor lug tires provide 27" of ground clearance. The big tires

also provide flotation and make the cart pull easier than it would on small tires.

Eight-bolt hubs with 2¾" spindles support a maximum load of 24,000 pounds, including the cart. The tires run on 120" centers and straddle four 30-inch rows.

Black or blue carts are available with white tanks; green carts come with yellow tanks. Some farmers prefer to mount two tanks on the carts so they can carry two different liquids.

List price with the tank and saddle is \$10,364. The same cart without a tank and saddle is \$7,889.
